Health requirements

City officials are urging individuals with symptoms of illness to stay home. Masks are required at indoor and many outdoor settings.

For all indoor settings that expect more than 1,000 visitors, patrons must show proof of vaccination or a recent negative COVID test (*72 hours*) at the door for entrance.
